We feel proud of how settled and purposeful our learning environments are and we think that this is due to a variety of reasons.

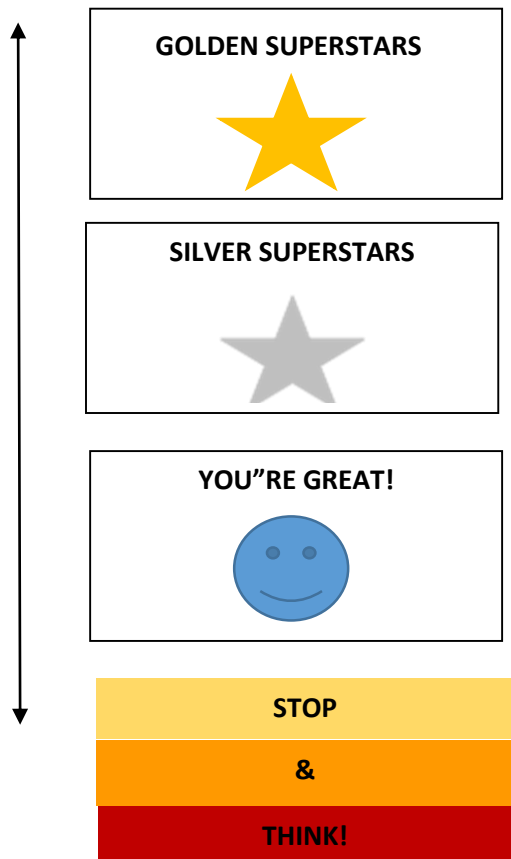
- Lessons which are fun and engaging

It is a primary aim of our school that every member of the school community feels valued and respected, and that each person is treated fairly and well. We are a caring community, whose values are built on mutual trust and respect for all. The school's behaviour policy is therefore designed to support the way in which all members of the school can live and work together in a supportive way. It aims to promote an environment in which everyone feels happy, safe, valued and secure.

We have a whole school approach to behaviour and expectations with clear guidelines on how good behaviour is rewarded and what the sanctions are for unacceptable behavior.

Star charts in every classroom

Star of the day _____



- Star of the day / lesson take home a pre-printed certificate / card
- Golden Superstars get a gold sticker
- Silver Superstars get a silver sticker
- All children begin on 'You're Great!' at the start of the day.
- STOP – Warning
- & - 10 minutes of break time
- THINK! – Whole break (pupils may be asked to leave the room)

- Children can move up and down the chart until they get to Orange / Red where they cannot move back up until they have completed their consequence. It is then a fresh start on 'You're Great.'

We praise and reward children for good behaviour in a variety of ways:

- Teachers congratulate children, use positive praise and stickers
- Teachers give children house points for good learning behaviours.
- Teachers select a class superstar every two weeks which is presented in our celebration assembly and focuses around demonstration of our core school values.
- Through our playground pals scheme, children nominate others who have shown our core values whilst out on the playground.

The school acknowledges all the efforts and achievements of children, both in and out of school. The celebration assembly provides opportunities for us to celebrate the wider achievements of pupils beyond school life. See our policy for further detail.
