- Librarian



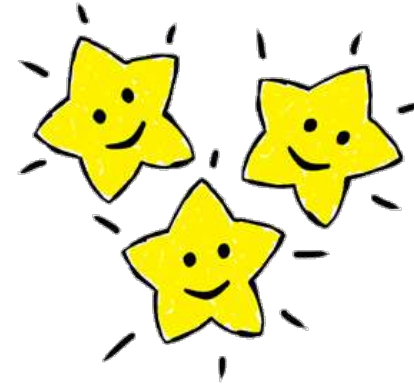

- Handing in homework



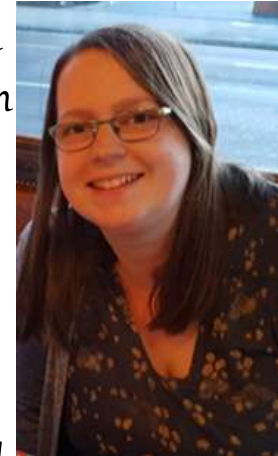

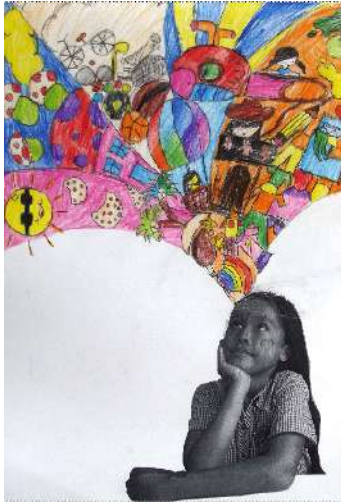

Use any art medium to add your interests in an artistic way

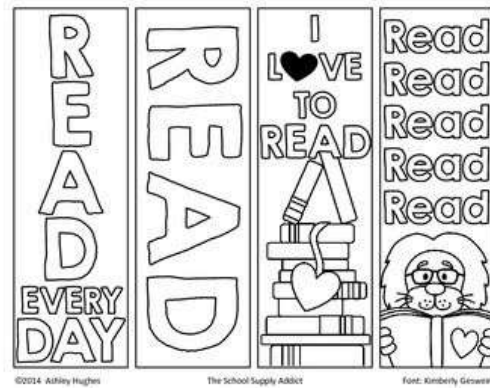


Bring your art work in on your first day back so that we can put the best ones on display!
