


Science-Lifecycles

This half term, the children will be learning about lifecycles. The children will be looking at the lifecycles of a frog, plant and then next half term, looking at the lifecycle of a human. To support the children with their learning, you could plant a seed and discuss the different stages as they happen. The children will be able to explain the different parts of a plant and share their understanding of the lifecycle with you after learning this at school .
