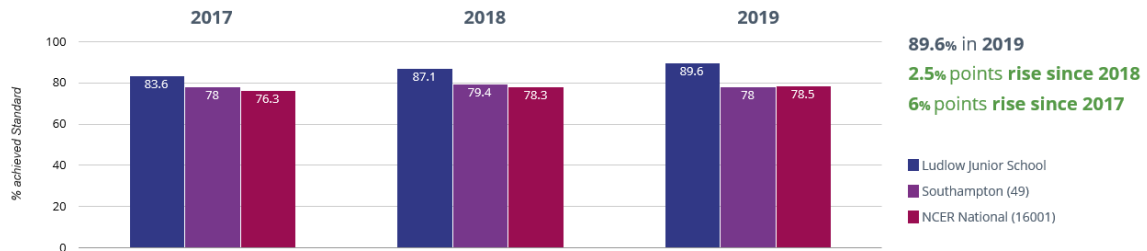


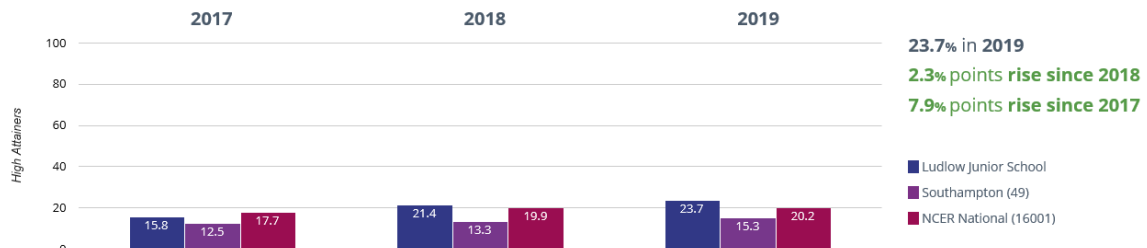
KS2 SATs Outcomes 2019

These tables show the SATs results at the end of the academic year 2018/19 for our school, compared to Local Authority Schools and other schools nationally. 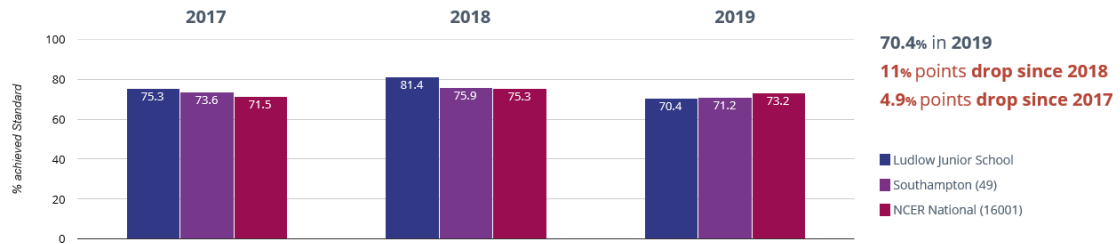
Writing - achieved standard



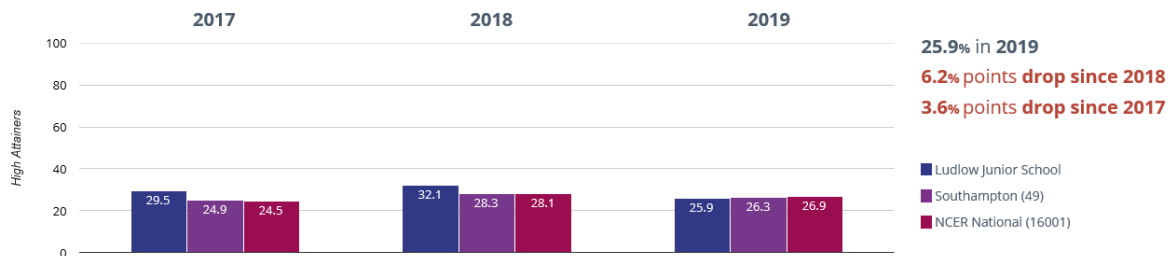
Writing - high attainers



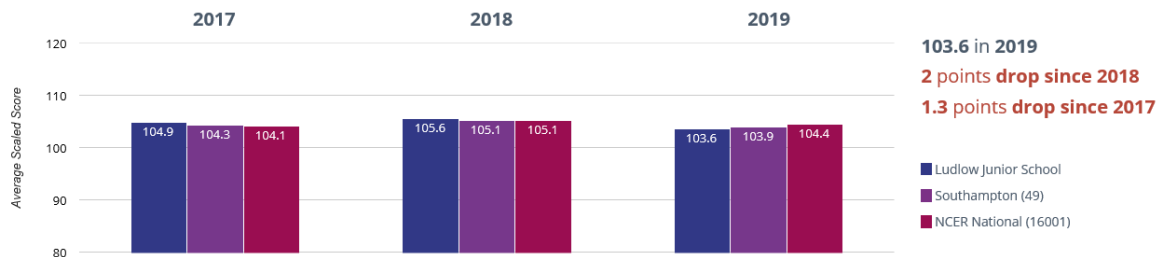
Reading - achieved standard



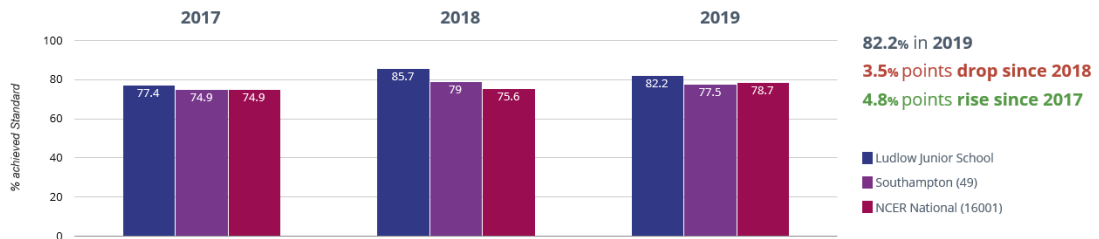
Reading - high attainers



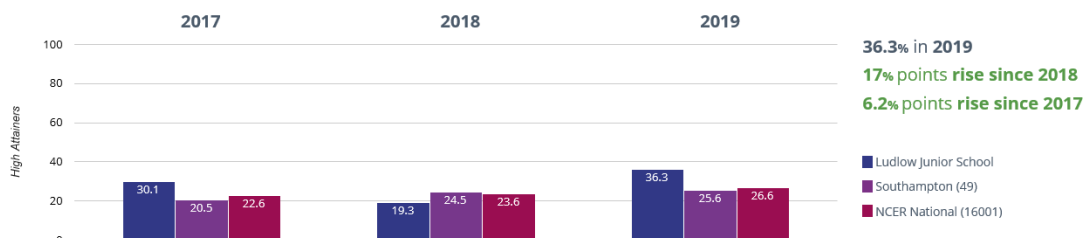
Reading - average scaled score



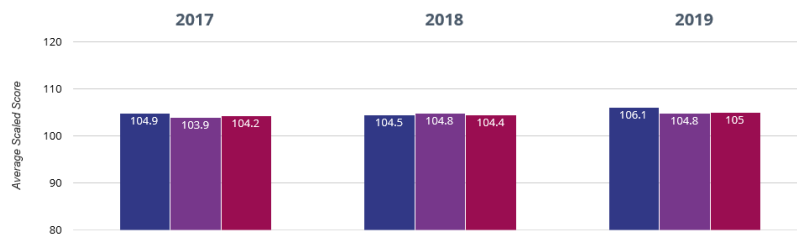
Maths - achieved standard



Maths - high attainers

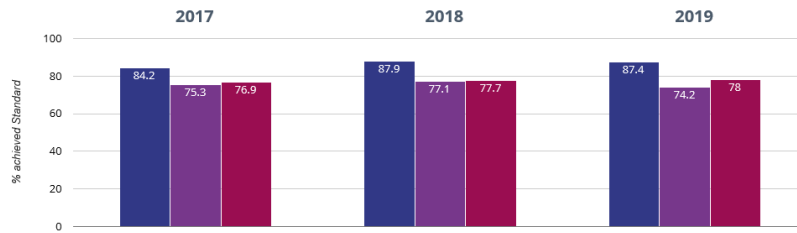

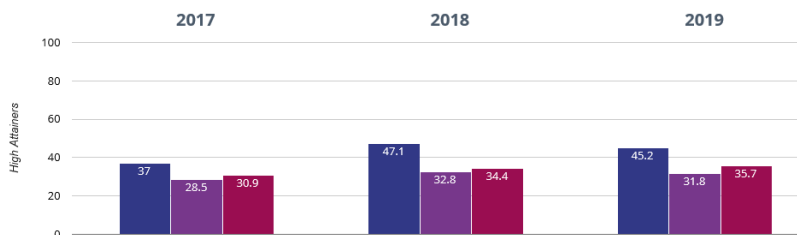

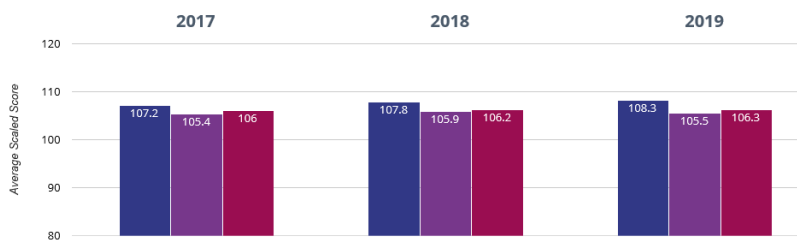

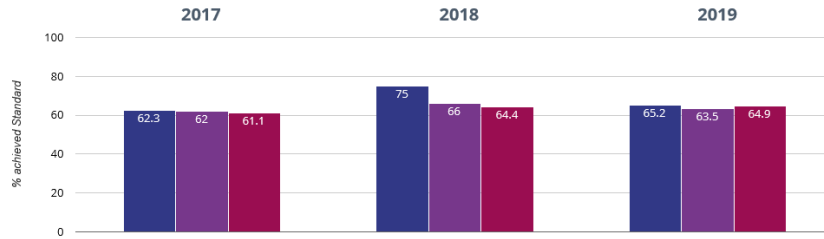

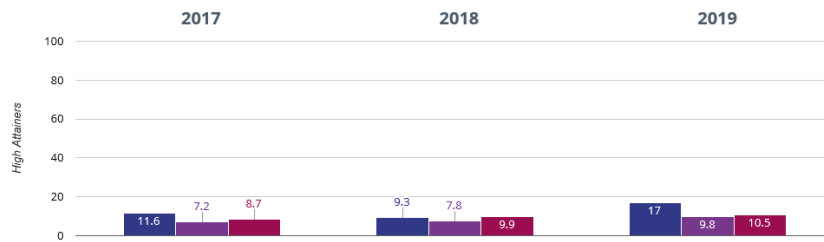
